(March 6, 2018)** – The Downtown Sacramento Partnership's Old Sacramento district office is excited to invite the community to the Annual St. Patrick's Day Parade on Saturday, March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2018. The parade path will start at Front and L Street, head north on Front Street, turn right on J Street, right on 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, right on L Street, and finish at Front Street and Neasham Circle.

Following the parade, traditional Ceili band, the Mighty Murphys, will play from 2-3pm. Incorporating extensive musical experience from various genres, the band sparkles with upbeat Irish reels, jigs, and slip jigs, plus heart-felt ballads of the old country and tunes that fit the traditional Irish style.
