Atypyk Snow Storm Globe from Paris Eiffel Tower

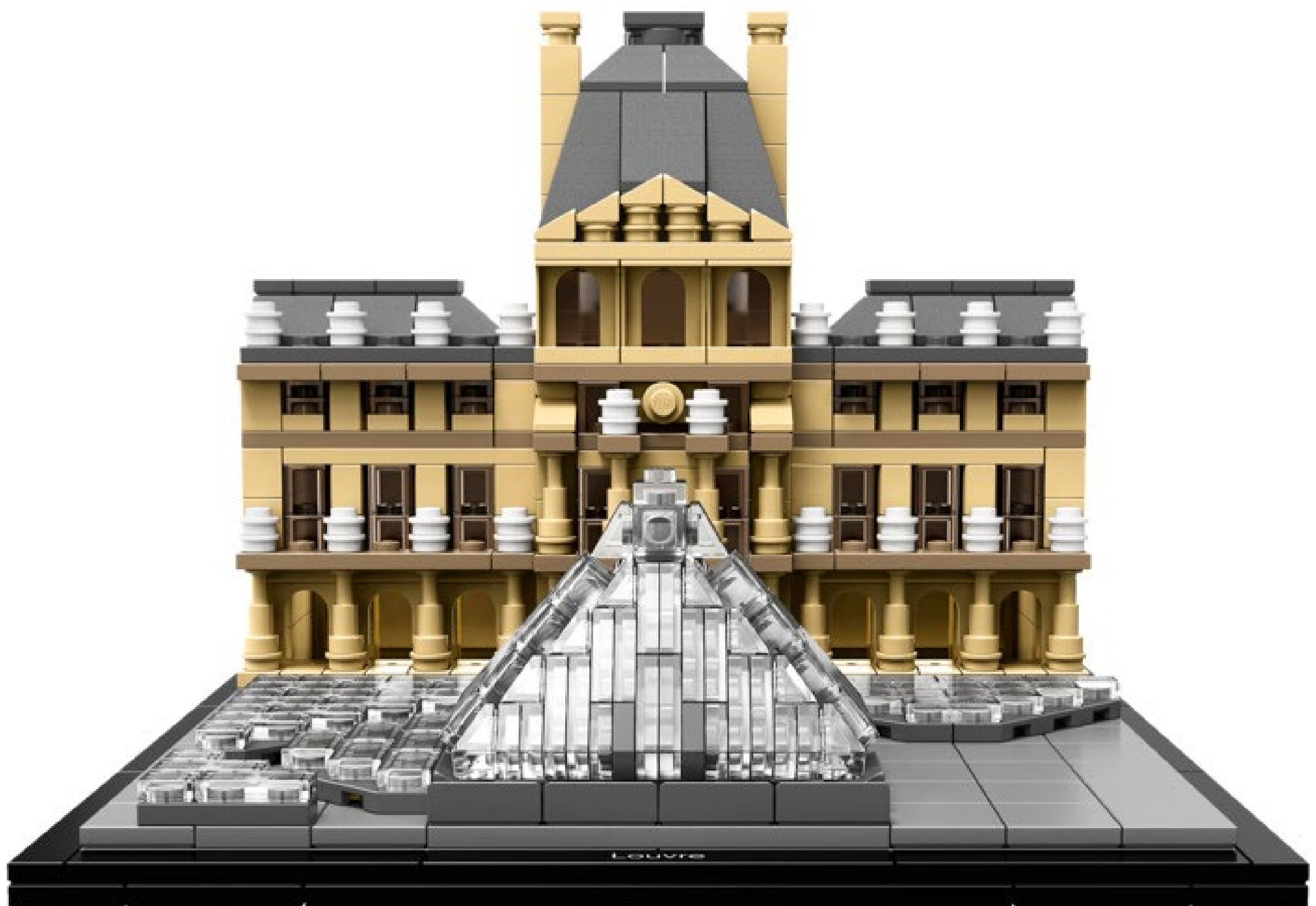

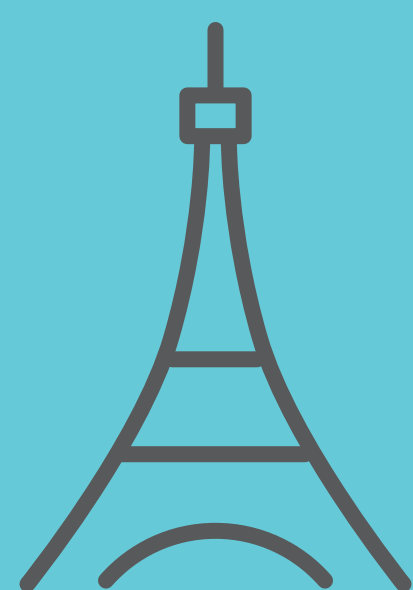

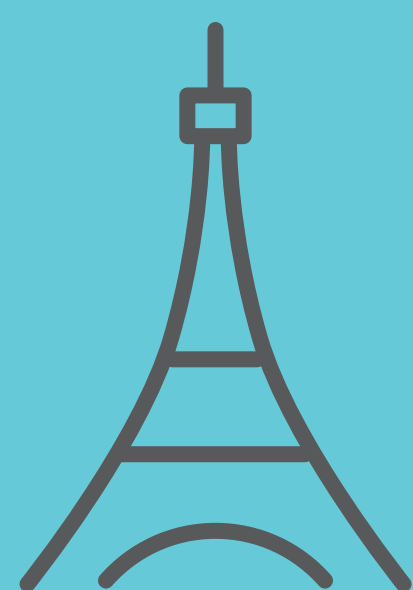
